(Recto) Clenched right hand of grinning soldier supporting Harold's feet; right hand grasping staff and left (leaning on pommel), for William; right hand signalling with index finger and left curved support, for helmeted soldier in right background holding his wounded companion; left hand with stretched out fingers for soldier at far right facing away; left hand with palm upwards for soldier supporting Harold's feet; right hand clasping staff,

unidentified [soldier behind William, holding flag]. (Verso) Nude study of the helmeted soldier and wounded companion; outline of his raised right arm; outlines of part of leg and foot with and without stockings, (?) for the old man behind soldier supporting Harold's feet. 482-493. Studies are survivors of a set of 36 originally at the gallery. The remaining 14 were damaged beyond repair during 1939-45 war
