### Description

Heart-shaped charm with a loop at the top for suspension. It has a tin body, silver in colour, set with a light blue glass heart with a raised surface on one side, and a glass bead in the centre. Heart charms were worn commonly in East London to preserve good health or occasionally as love charms. This specimen was obtained from hawkers in
