## Burial-Urn

Roman burial urn. Circular dark-brown earthenware vessel. It has four inscribed lines around edge where the pot is widest, but is otherwise plain. It has a rectangular halo where a Cuming label used to be. Found at the site of

the Post Office on St. Martins Le Grand, in 1824.
