Figure of Osiris, painted red with an elaborate collar of blue, green, yellow and red. Osiris figures were placed in tombs of wealthy Egyptians in the New Kingdom. They contained scrolls of the Book of the Dead, which instructed the deceased how to live in the Afterlife.
